

Yanyan Zhu 朱彥晏- Guqin Player

In 1990's, Yanyan Zhu learned Guqin (ancient Literati Arts) from top Masters in China, who were recognized as national Guqin Music descendents. And at the moment only few people in the world still could play the music from ancient time back to Zhou Dynasty (1047 BC-221BC), and only less than 10 teachers in China could instruct students privately.

Her repertoire includes Jinling School, Zhucheng School, Guangling School, Wumen (Yushan) School, and Chuan School since she learned from several schools' masters. She is devoted to the

in-depth study of the Zhucheng School, writing scores for the Zhucheng School's ancestry notation book [Long Yin Guan Qinpu].

In the 1990s, she began to study Kunqu (Ming Dynasty poetry songs) under Shi Runlan and Zhu Jiyun, masters of Kunqu from The Kunju Opera Institute of Jiangsu Province. She excavated and arranged traditional Chinese poetry song repertoires and created and played music with a unique literati culture style.

Yanyan loves Literati music culture heritage which had been almost lost in the past century, when few people know about the Guqin instrument, literati Guqin music (some company with Xiao-flute) poetry songs (company with Guqin and Xiao). Kunqu songs (company with Di-flute).

In 2002, Yanyan immigrated to Canada, started to teach Guqin music privately. She has been a professional Qin-Music master performing in concerts with Toronto Chinese Symphony Orchestra since 2005.

In 2008, she was invited to present Guqin music and poetry songs in Taiwan in several cities by **Fo Guang Shan Monastery** 

In 2009, She recorded her Gugin solo and distributed first Gugin Music CD online.

In 2011, she was invited to New York Qin Society to demonstrate Qin music and Poetry songs (http://newyorkgin.com/events/2011/2011event4.html).

In 2016, she was the Toronto Chinese Media Award Recipient for her outstanding contribution to the community arts and culture heritage programs which benefited all ages of Canadians.

In 2017, she published a bilingual book, "Literati," (ISBN 978-0-9959481) to introduce "ten thousand years of wisdom, living freedom for today" for young readers, and edited several Tang Dynasty Poets' selected poem collections for Professor John Warden (UoT) and Daqi Dai (YRSDB), who also contributed in Poetry Songs English version lyrics for Yanyan presented Poetry Songs concerts in the past 8 years.
